Issue Filing Layout

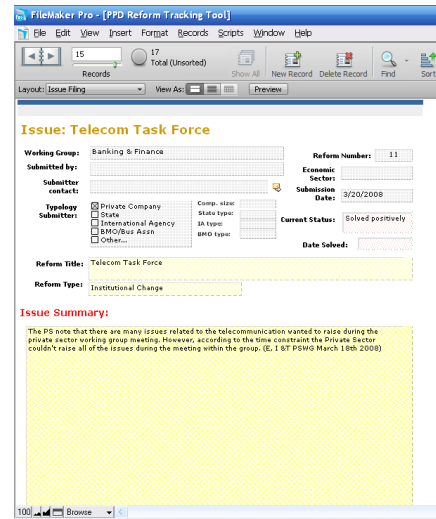
This first layout is intended to be fed with all the information concerning an issue. This is the Data Entry Layout.

The layout is divided into 6 pages

Page 1:

1- Background Information of the Issue submission

- Working Group Name: A drop-down list is set with a value list which is predefined but can be modified. [\(See section 3\)](#)..
- Submitter Name and Contact Details
- Submitter Type which can be a private company, a State , an NGO or an International Agency representative – those types have to be specified in the appropriate fields.
- The number of the Issue is generated automatically
- Economic Sector of the Issue
- The Submission Date of the Issue
- The current status of the issue which is specified into: - current agenda; solved positively (= in line with recommendation of the PS); solved negatively (government say no to it); is outdated (circumstances have changed); on hold (the government refuses, or doesn't have an answer or larger framework needs to be put in place before solving this issue) and has been reformulated
- If the issue was solved, the date of it.

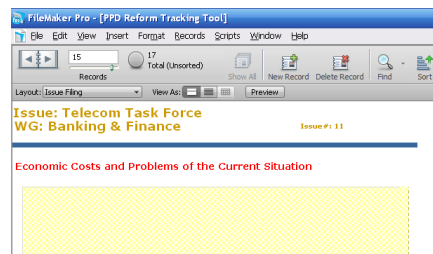

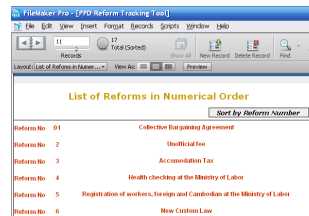

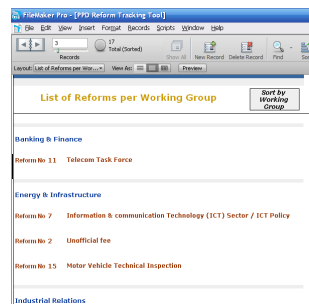

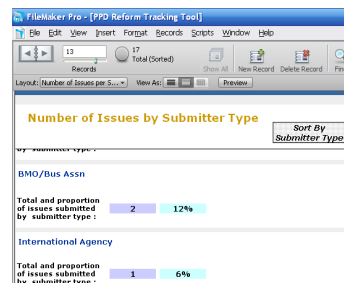

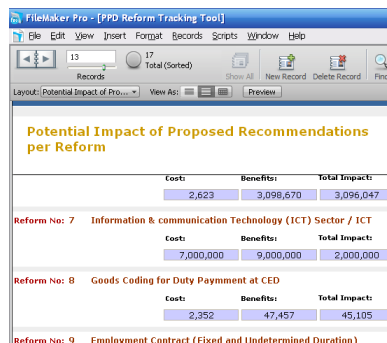
